What proportion of children currently at the school have SEND?

We have 231 children on roll across school; of which 28 are currently identified as having SEN and are on our SEN register. We have identified 18 additional children who require 'Early Support' and whose progress is carefully monitored.

21 are identified as requiring SEN support, that is provision over and above usual classroom practice, and 6 have undergone a Statutory Assessment by the Local Authority and have an Education, Health and Care (EHC) Plan. All children identified as 'SEN Support' have an Individual 'My Support' Plan that details interventions and support.

The needs of the children on the SEN register vary greatly; including Dyslexia, Autism Spectrum Conditions and behavioural difficulties as well as children with general learning delay and medical diagnoses.
